What is Botox used to treat?

Botox is derived from botulinum toxin, a substance that has been used for over 15 years to treat muscle spasms of the eyes. We use Botox to treat numerous facial wrinkles caused from habitual expressions, such as:

- Frown lines/wrinkles
- Crow's feet
- Forehead lines
- Excessive sweating of underarms or palms, also known as hyperhidrosis

What is the procedure and will the results last?

Botox is injected into muscles that cause lines and wrinkles. After the injection, the effect reaches a peak in approximately two weeks and lasts four to six months. The relaxation of muscles allows the lines to disappear. After repeated injections, the effect will last longer and longer leaving the face looking relaxed.
